Don was introduced and stated that he was not a veteran, but as a native of San Francisco, he has been attending the VIG for several years and volunteering for the VA for 10 years. For the last three years, he has been serving the veterans out of the San Mateo county jail. Sunny Campbell spoke of his 30 years in the USMC. "My concern is wanting to help veterans grow", and pledged his continuing support.

Chairman Beavers thanked Sunny Campbell, JLynn Manley, Gloria Godchaux, Rhonda Harris, Marian, Don, Heather and Steve Emrick for their participation at this meeting.

A motion to adjourn the meeting by Mr. Faison and seconded by Mr. Hutto. A vote was taken and the motion passed. The meeting adjourned.
