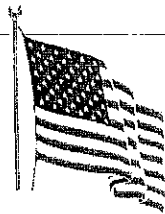


Chairman Beavers thanked J Lynn Manley for her participation at this meeting.
